# PRELIMS RULES & REGULATIONS

## LASYA

Lasya is a dance extravaganza which brings uniquely talented and phenomenal graceful dancers together in a celebration of myriad dance styles. The winners of prelims will be selected for the final round.

### REGISTRATION

- Register through the attached registration form.
- Participants registered must confirm their presence on the day of the event.
- For participants from Pune, Bengaluru, Chennai & Hyderabad, we will have offline prelims in their city.
- Participants from cities, other than Pune, Bengaluru, Chennai & Hyderabad, need to upload a video of their performance adhering the rules mentioned below.

### TEAM REGISTRATION

- Team registration should be done under a name which will be carried throughout till the finals.
- One registration form per team providing names and contact details (Phone no. and mail id) of 3 members.
- Team should consist of maximum 15 members.

### SOLO REGISTRATION

- Each individual should mention their own and emergency contact number.

### RULES OF EVENT

#### GROUP

- 1 performance : Maximum 10 minutes

#### SOLO

- 1 performance : Maximum 4 minutes

## LASYA

### RULES OF EVENT

#### GENERAL

- The audio should also be brought in the form of pendrive or CD incase of a technical glitch. (For participants from Pune, Hyderabad, Chennai & Bengaluru)
- The video of your dance should be uploaded on the google form provided at the top or at the end of this document. (For other cities)
- There is no restrictions on the dance style in CARVAAN.
- Props and accessories are allowed but participants are expected to carry them on their own, at their own risk. No extra points will be given for their usage.
- The use of fire, water or any item that could damage the stage or hinder the performance of other teams will lead to disqualification.

### JUDGING CRITERIA

**(subject to flexibility according to judges)**

#### GROUP

- Judgement will be based on creativity (2); rhythm (2); formation (2); coordination (3); expressions (1). Total 10 points .
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

#### SOLO

- Judgement will be based on rhythm (2); clarity of steps (2); ; expressions (1); versatility (1); creativity (2); overall stage presence (2). Total 10 points .
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

**Crescendo provides a platform for the college circuit's musicians to showcase their skills and leave a mark on the world of music.**

### REGISTRATION

- Register through the attached registration form.
- Participants registered must confirm their presence on the day of the event.
- Each individual should mention their own emergency contact number.
- For participants from Pune, Bengaluru, Chennai & Hyderabad, we will have offline prelims in their city.
- Participants from cities, other than Pune, Bengaluru, Chennai & Hyderabad, need to upload a video of their performance adhering the rules mentioned below.

### RULES OF EVENT *GENERAL*

- Open to all.
- Three categories are : Vocals(Eastern/Classical), Vocals(Western) and Instrumental.
- Any language or genre is fine but NO RAP.
- No backing track with the instrument is allowed.
- Participants are not allowed to play any instrument as a backing track either.

## CRESCENDO

### RULES OF EVENT

#### *OFFLINE PRELIMS*

- The contestants will be asked to prepare 3 songs.  
(Note: The contestants may sing as many songs as they want. The judges may ask for a change of song, so as to judge better, hence recommended to prepare 3 songs.)
- They will be asked to prepare 2-3 min of each song.  
However, the total time/contestant will be left to the judges.
- Participants are requested to bring their own Tanpura, if you need one.
- For instrumental, they can prepare anything for 3-4 min.
- 2-3 finalists will be selected from each category.

#### *ONLINE PRELIMS*

- Submit a recording of your performance as audio on the form given above.
- The audio should be no longer than 4 minutes.
- The audio should not contain any karaoke or backing vocals.

## BATTLE OF BANDS

**Pravega's Battle of Bands, a musical competition that attracts talent from all over the country and showcases the best music you may have yet heard. The competition consists of preliminary rounds where 5-10 bands per region will be chosen based on the submitted music sample to participate in live rounds in Pravega XI.**

### ELIGIBILITY

- Any band not signed to a major record label or has not released an album on a major label is eligible to compete.

### REGISTRATION

- Bands must register through the attached registration form.
- Applications should include the name of the band, a list of members and their instruments, and a music sample, which should be a video of the band performing.
- The band must have at least 3 members and not more than 7.
- The band need to upload a video with good quality audio on the registration link.

### RULES OF EVENT

- Each band can perform for a maximum performance time of 15 minutes.
- A strict penalty will be imposed for exceeding time limit.
- All bands can perform songs across genres and have no language limit.
- There is no restriction on the number of songs a team can perform if the time limit is adhered to.

## BATTLE OF BANDS

### JUDGING

A panel of judges will score each band based on the following criteria:

- Stage presence
- Musicianship
- Tightness of the band
- Originality and creativity
- Selection of material / Composition quality
- Skill and technique of every member and collectively as a band
- Adherence to time limit

The judges' decision is irrevocable, and any opposition and pleas will not be entertained.

The fashion event of Pravega, Eleganté will provide a stage for the designers to showcase their creativity and a runway to the models to show off their unique style.

### REGISTRATION

- Register through the attached registration form.
- Participants registered must confirm their presence on the day of the event.
- For participants from Pune, Bengaluru, Chennai & Hyderabad, we will have offline prelims in their city.
- Participants from cities, other than Pune, Bengaluru, Chennai & Hyderabad, need to upload a video of their performance adhering the rules mentioned below.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

- This is a group event. No individual participation is allowed.
  - Each team can have a maximum of 12 members
- Note: No restriction on the number of designers.
- Photos of each team will be taken for verification purposes.
  - The team must be registered under a name that will be carried throughout till the finals.
  - All the members' names, contact numbers, and mail IDs must be registered.
  - Prelims will not be restricted to a particular theme. The teams are free to choose their theme at their convenience.
  - There is only one round.
  - No props will be provided. All the things needed for the show must be brought by the team.
  - The costumes and accessories must be brought by the team.
  - The timings must be maintained strictly.
  - The use of hazardous props and objects, nudity, and obscenity is strictly prohibited. The use of any will lead to disqualification of the team.
  - The team can bring their own recorded music to be played during their performance.

## ELEGANTÉ

### EVENT

- The time allotted to each team is a maximum of 10 minutes. No extra second will be provided. This time is inclusive of entry and exit from the stage by the team members.
- The choreography/sequencing can be done in any order, but the things mentioned below are compulsory.
- Individual ramp walk by all the models (each model will have an average of 30 seconds ramp walk).
- And ramp walk as a team.

### JUDGING CRITERIA

- The decision of the judge is final & non-negotiable.
  - For modeling: The models will be judged on their Style, Ramp Walk, Presentation and execution, Confidence, and Attitude.
  - For choreography: The style and presentation as a whole team also will be considered for team judgment.
  - For designing: The uniqueness, relevance to the theme, and how beautifully it is incorporated into the garment.
  - For each criterion, a maximum of 10 points will be given. And the final score will lead to the selection of the teams for finals.
- \*The judging criteria might be prone to little changes depending on the judges of the event.

## FOOTPRINTS

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Each team must consist of minimum of 4 and a maximum of 10 actors.
- The competition will be conducted in an open area (barring unforeseen issues like bad weather etc.), and there will be no microphones or speakers provided. The teams must bring their own speakers and/or musical instruments for playing music or other sound effects.
- The teams will be given 15 minutes to act out their street play, exceeding which points will be deducted.
- No props will be provided at the venue. Teams must bring their own props/costumes for the event and will be responsible for any such belongings brought (including musical instruments).
- No time will be given prior to the event for rehearsals.
- Multiple entries from a single campus will be accepted.
- No NSFW content will be accepted for consideration. Any teams with street plays including such content will be immediately disqualified from the competition.
- No politically sensitive or directly offensive contents will be entertained in the plays. This also includes directly referencing Institutes and Organizations in your play.
- Use of fire (even diyas, candles or lighters) and liquids are not allowed on the venue for safety reasons. However, bottles containing non-flammable substances will be permitted, provided that they are tightly closed and there is no risk of spilling.
- Any use of abusive language, indecent behavior, obscenity (at the discretion of judges) shall lead to direct disqualification.

## SHUTTERBUGS

### ELIGIBILITY

- The event is open to all active college students in India.

### THEME/TOPIC

#### **Resilience & Continuity**

This theme captures the strength to endure and thrive, even in the face of challenges. Capture how people and nature stay strong and keep going, even when things get tough. Your photos can highlight moments of perseverance, recovery, or the continuous flow of life despite difficulties.

### RULES OF EVENT

- The participants need to upload a total of 3 photographs (based on the topic) & an appropriate story/caption for each picture (in their own words)
- A on-spot selfie for conformation of the originality of the submitted photo.
- Digital enhancements that distort the reality of the image are not allowed. Only basic editing like sharpening, contrast adjustment, colour correction and simple cropping are permitted.
- Changes in density, contrast, color and/or saturation levels that significantly alter content by obscuring or eliminating elements in the photograph are not permitted.
- No synthetic or artificially generated images are allowed.
- Adding, rearranging, reversing, distorting or removing people and/or objects from within the frame is not permitted.
- Both colour & monochrome images will be accepted.
- The entries should not have any watermark on them.
