Chemenigma Prelims '24 rules and regulations

Team Chemenigma '24

Eligibility

Students in class 11 or above and have not completed their UG are eligible.

Teams

Teams can have at most three participants (solo participant is allowed, but we do not encourage solo participant because he/she may face difficulty in performing experiments, etc. in finals (if qualified)) and both must be eligible. The score and answers given by the organizers is final and there will be no consideration of any appeals.

Registration

Teams must register themselves on the Chemenigma website. For a team of two only one registration is sufficient. All teams must possess valid ID proof for determination of their education level and identity. The organizing team reserves the right to disbar participants found forging identities. Registration fee: Rs. 150

General Rules

- There will be two rounds of prelims held on October 19th and 20th respectively. Both the rounds will be held completely online. Please be updated by checking the website regularly or/and follow the Instagram page of scitech.pravega.
- The first round will be held on 19th and consists of 20-25 objective questions. The second round, held on 20th, will consist of 6 7 subjective questions. A total of 3-3.5 hours including time for making PDF, etc. will be given to solve each paper. (max. allowed time for writing and submission may change in future, so be updated).
- The candidates are free to use any non-living source they deem fit to aid their effort while solving problems.
- The question paper will be mailed to the teams on the day of the prelims. The answer scripts must be mailed back to <insert email> before the end of the stipulated time.
- The answer script must be in word document or pdf format and maybe typed or inked
- The top 4 teams will be selected to move on to the finals.
- The details of the finals will be communicated later.

Other Rules

- The details of marking, results and sample questions will be mailed to the teams' email id(s). Thus, it is a good idea that at least one team member has a working internet connection to receive all further updates.
- The solutions to subjective problems should be clear and decisive. Any discrepancy arising because of illegible solutions will not be entertained.
- In case the organizers are able to establish any inconsistencies, all such teams will be barred from participation in the present as well as future iterations of the event.
- The medium of both questions and solutions will be in English.
- The organizers retain the right to update, edit, and remove rules summarily by
 posting it on the website, thus the participants are encouraged to keep abreast of all
 active development
