EXHIBITIONS PRAVEGA XI, 2024

RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Eligibility

- i. Students of classes 6-12 and undergraduates are eligible for the competition.

 The three categories for the competition are:
 - Category A: Class 6-10
 - Category B: Class 11- 4th year undergraduate
- ii. Registration can be done both individually and as a team. Maximum number of members in a team can be 4.
- iii. All participants should have a valid student identity card issued by their respective institutions.

B. Exhibition guidelines

- i. The competition will be held in two rounds, the prelims and the final round.
- ii. Exhibits/ computer simulations should be original and completed by the participants. The projects can be aimed at solving any real world problem or demonstrate some scientific concept.
 - iii. Participants should submit a brief written description or abstract of the project outlining objectives, methods and conclusions.
- iii. Students participating as a team ensure that the contribution of each team member is clearly specified in the submitted report .
- iv. Each team/ individual will be given a maximum of 10 minutes to explain their projects to the judges.
- v. Points will be awarded on the basis of scientific understanding, creativity, accuracy, written report and presentation.
- vi. The use of live animals, hazardous materials and potentially dangerous equipment is strictly prohibited. Ensure that proper safety measures are followed.
- vii. The selected teams/ individuals from each city will be invited to IISc for the final round during one of the days of Pravega. Travelling allowance and accommodation will be provided to the finalists. Exact timings and other details of the final round will be conveyed later.
